## **Geography**

Can you record the weather in Cleethorpes over a three-day period? Take the temperature, catch and measure any rainfall and see if you can use a weather app to find out the wind direction and speed.

Design a weather map (similar to those on the weather reports) to show the weather on one of your chosen days and create new weather symbols designed by you.

Plan a day out based on the weather of one of your recorded days. Find activities to do based on the weather, consider where you would have lunch and dinner, what clothing you would need to wear and any supplies needed (e.g if it was a sunny day, you would need sun cream, hats, lots of drinks etc).
